

Durable Power of Attorney

cereneo Schweiz AG (**cereneo**) is a Swiss clinic and research facility specialised in neurorehabilitation.

to be my duly and lawfully appointed attorney-in-fact in order to perform any and all legal acts falling within the scope of authority of a general attorney-in-fact, and in particular to accept a proposal and to enter into a contract with cereneo in the name and on behalf of me for the provision of services by cereneo to me. To the extent that such proposal has already been accepted and such contract has already been entered into by the Attorney-in-fact, I hereby explicitly approve and ratify such proposal and contract. I hereby explicitly agree that personal data of whatsoever nature relating to myself, which may also be covered by any professional secrecy (including, but not limited to medical data covered by the medical secrecy), may be disclosed to the Attorney-in-fact orally or in writing without any restrictions.

The Principal and the Attorney-in-fact take note that the contractual relationship with cereneo is subject to and that he/she will be personally bound by the terms and conditions set forth in the proposal for the provision of services by cereneo and the "General Terms and Conditions of cereneo Schweiz AG" (version dated 1 August 2016), including, but not limited to provisions concerning the **governing law, place of jurisdiction, limitation of liability** and **data protection** set forth therein.

cereneo explicitly reserves the right to request evidence satisfactory to cereneo that the Principal has legal capacity to appoint the Attorney-in-fact and/or that the Attorney-in-fact had the legal power to enter into a contract with cereneo in the name and on behalf of the Principal (including, but not limited to provisions concerning the governing law, place of jurisdiction, limitation of liability and data protection set forth therein). If the Principal (or the Attorney-in-fact) fails to provide such evidence in form and substance satisfactory to cereneo, cereneo may withdraw from the contract and deny the Principal admission for treatment in cereneo's sole discretion, in which case neither the Principal nor the Attorney-in-fact shall have any claims whatsoever against cereneo.

This power of attorney shall be governed by substantive laws of Switzerland excluding the conflict of laws rules. Exclusive place of jurisdiction is the seat of cereneo in 6354 Vitznau, Switzerland. This power of attorney does not expire upon the death, official declaration of disappearance, incapacity to act, or bankruptcy of the Principal.
